Fire Authority Board:

We responded to 100 total incidents for the month of September, bringing the 2022 year to date calls to 803 placing us 42 request for services up over the same time frame last year. September calls included a fire at a business in the City and one aid to Grattan FD on a reported fire.

Brenda attend three days at the Women in Fire 2022 International Conference in Orlando. During this conference she learned different hose load and stretching techniques as well as Firefighter rescue courses.

We are in the midst of our ISO audit. This review of department equipment training, readiness, area, and policy takes place every five years and will assign a rating used by insurance companies to help set rates. There is a sizable amount of data put into this report and will take 6 to 9 months to receive our score once the site audit is completed.

Captain Donahue, Lieutenant Hults, Lieutenant Kelley, and myself attended a situational awareness course from Dr. Richard Gasaway hosted by Western Michigan Association of Fire Chiefs. This was a great one-day training aimed at growing the Officers situational awareness.

The EMT class we are hosted has been completed, all members have passed the course and are now on to test for NREMT. Chris Tomic and Ian Shears have started their EMT course at Life Ambulance, this course will wrap up in January 2023.

We held try-outs last month resulting in hiring 4 new paid on call members. Tony Ellis, Nick Martin, Kelly Nietupski, and Keith Debbaudt will be starting Fire training this month at Kentwood Fire Department. With the hiring of these four puts us a full paid on call/part time roster.

Fallasburg Fall Festival Chicken BBQ sales were down this year, however thanks to some first time sponsors our overall profit was up a couple of hundred dollars. Thanks to all of you for stopping out to help out or support us.

Our open house / trunk or treat event is set for October 29th 6-9pm. Please feel welcome to come by and check things out, of course if you have time and would like to help out we will have plenty to do.

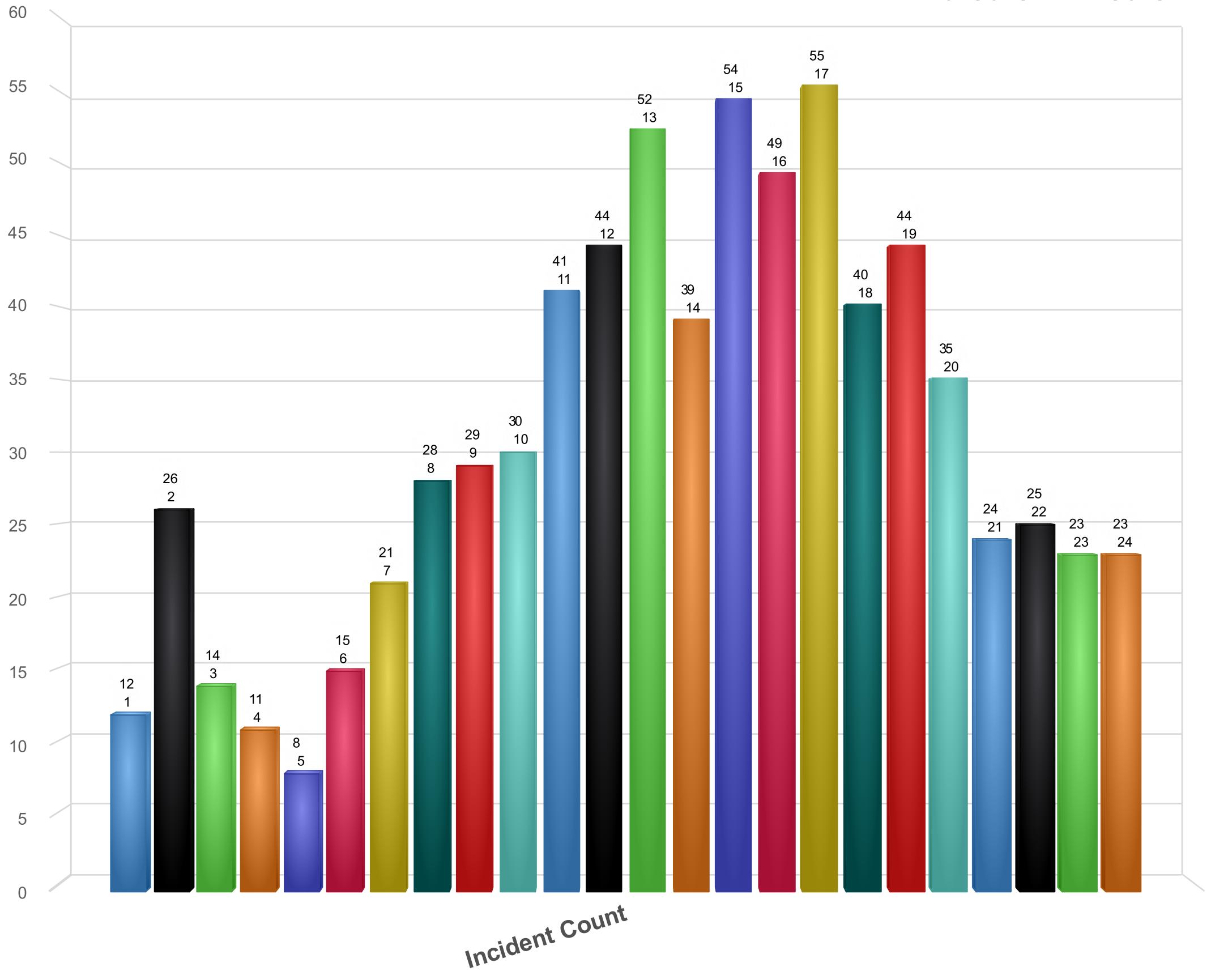

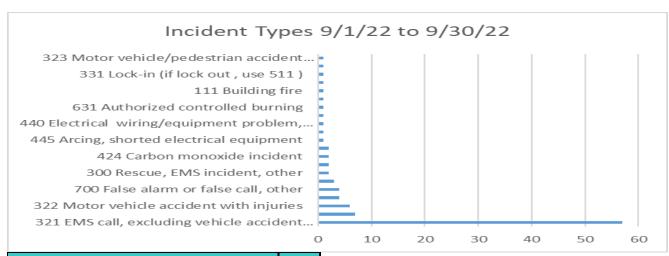


Incidents Per Hour of Day 01/01/22-12/31/22
